Players Responsibilities

1. Representing your Team and Club in a Sportsmanlike manner.
2. Signing Club and association papers as required by the Club.
3. Attending coaching / training sessions for your team. Including the paying of funds to cover any expenses of training. Attend other team events as requested by your Manager (e.g. for Photographs, area trials, additional training sessions, Presentations, etc.).
4. Maintaining your own fitness and inform the Team Manager of any injury or illness preventing you playing or training.
5. Contact your Manager if unclear about Team selection or travel arrangements for games.
6. Pay Club fees to the club in a timely manner preferably by direct debit.
7. Maintaining the good condition of the club's property. This may include but not be limited to: Club Strip, Balls, Cones, Corner flags, First aid kit, Nets, Bibs, Subs. Suits, etc.
8. Supplying your own Boots, shin pads etc. and wearing appropriate outer garments for the weather assuming you will be substituted for some of any match. Do not bring unnecessary valuables to matches or training. Your Manager will not be responsible for any losses however caused.
9. Arrange transportation to matches. Tell your Manager if you have spaces to take other players.
10. Attend and assist with Fund raising events. Put forward Fund raising suggestions to your Manager.
11. Bring Sponsorship opportunities to the attention of your Manager.
12. Players 16 or over should attend the AGM. Players under 16 should encourage a parent or guardian to attend on their behalf.
13. While good conduct on and off the field is expected from all Tattenhoe Youth Football Club members. Occasionally fines for Yellow or Red cards given by Referee decisions will be imposed on the club and paid by the club. Where such fines are for action within the control of the player the club requires reimbursement from the player. Such reimbursement will be for actions such as threatening or abusive behaviour, swearing, striking another player or official etc. Such conduct may also incur further penalties from the club.
